



MONTROSE WALL OF FAME



PURPOSE

The Wall of Fame recognizes former student-athletes, coaches, teams, and outstanding contributors whose achievements, leadership, and sportsmanship have brought exceptional distinction to our school's athletic programs. Inductees exemplify integrity, dedication, and excellence both during and beyond their athletic careers.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



STUDENT ATHLETES

Student-athlete nominees must have demonstrated outstanding athletic achievement, including but not limited to:

- All-conference, all-district, all-state, or comparable honors
- School, conference, or state records
- Significant contributions to team success (e.g., championships, playoff advancement)

Nominees must also have demonstrated good sportsmanship and character during their high school career.



COACHES

Coach nominees must:

- Have served as a head or assistant coach at Montrose High School for a minimum of five (5) years
- Be retired or no longer coaching at the school for at least two (2) years at the time of nomination

Coach nominees must also have demonstrated:

- Sustained success and leadership
- Positive impact on student-athletes
- Contributions to the development and integrity of the athletic program



TEAMS

Teams may be nominated based on exceptional achievement, such as:

- Conference, district, sectional, or state championships
- Undefeated or historically significant seasons
- Achievements that brought lasting recognition to the school

Team nominations must be at least ten (10) years removed from the season of accomplishment.



OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTOR

Outstanding Contributors are exceptional supporters of Montrose High School athletics. These individuals have provided opportunity and encouragement to teams or the athletic department as a whole. As with candidates who are athletes or coaches, their service and dedication shall have advanced the maturation of Montrose High Athletes and programs.

A nominee's character will also receive consideration.

STANDARDS FOR CONSIDERATION

- ✓ Demonstrated sportsmanship, integrity, and ethical behavior
- ✓ Conduct that reflects positively on the school and its athletic programs
- ✓ Achievements must be clearly documented and verifiable
- ✓ Nominees must not have engaged in conduct that would discredit the school or diminish the honor of induction

SELECTION PROCESS



The Wall of Fame Selection Committee will review nominations and announce its decisions in early spring.

The committee will consist of seven (7) members, including:

- A current officer of the Montrose Athletic Booster Club
- A current Montrose High School varsity coach
- A current Montrose School Board member
- A current Montrose administrator

The remaining three at-large members will be selected from the Montrose Booster Club or Montrose School District faculty.

In addition, all committee members must currently meet MSHSAA citizenship requirements.
